What Can You Do?

- Don't bring firewood into North Dakota; use local sources.
- If someone you know is coming to North Dakota, tell him or her to leave firewood at home. If someone already has brought it, burn it immediately!
- Learn to know the signs and symptoms of emerald ash borer and report possible occurrences.
- Plant tree species other than ash (*Fraxinus* spp.). EAB only attacks ash trees. There are no known resistant species or cultivars. A high percentage of trees in North Dakota communities are ash.
